1. Basque Country, A long term strategy: Klima 2050



- Small region.
- High density population.
- Surface area **7,234.8 km²**.
- **23%** of the surface area: **Natural spaces**.
- Population: **2,180,449** inhabitants.
- Coastal population: **1,400,000** inhabitants.
- Cities: **Bilbao** (Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize 2010).
Donostia/San Sebastián (European Capital of Culture 2016).
Vitoria-Gasteiz (European Green capital 2012).
- Per capita income: **129%** Third place in the European ranking (Europe Union: 100%).
- Official languages: **Basque**, a unique language with no known connection to other languages of the word; and **Spanish**.
- Environmental Performance Index: **69.7**. Basque Country is 4th ranked country place in Europa.

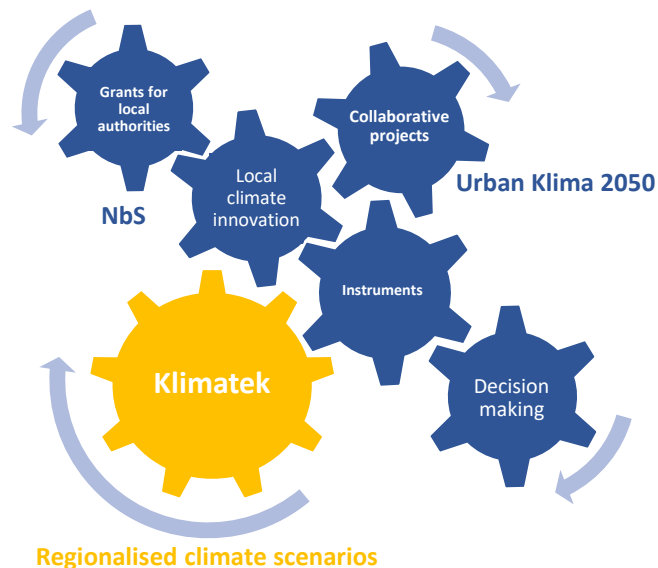

ACCESIT: Vulnerability analysis of linear infrastructures,

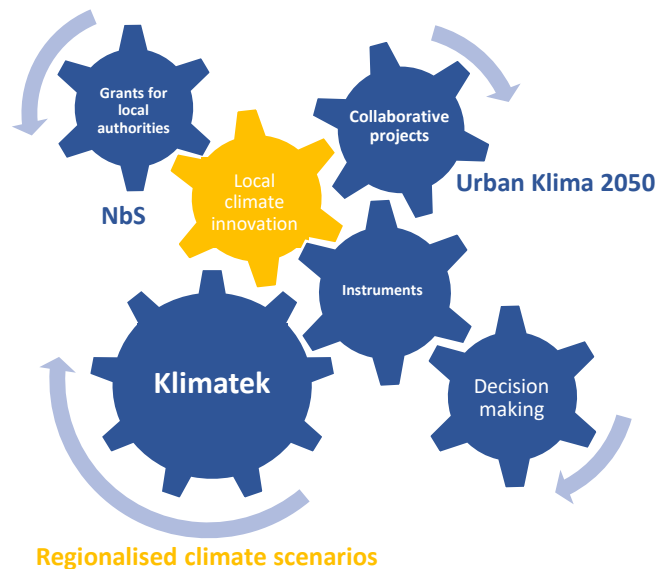
EkoReg: Including adaptation in comprehensive urban regeneration in neighbourhoods,

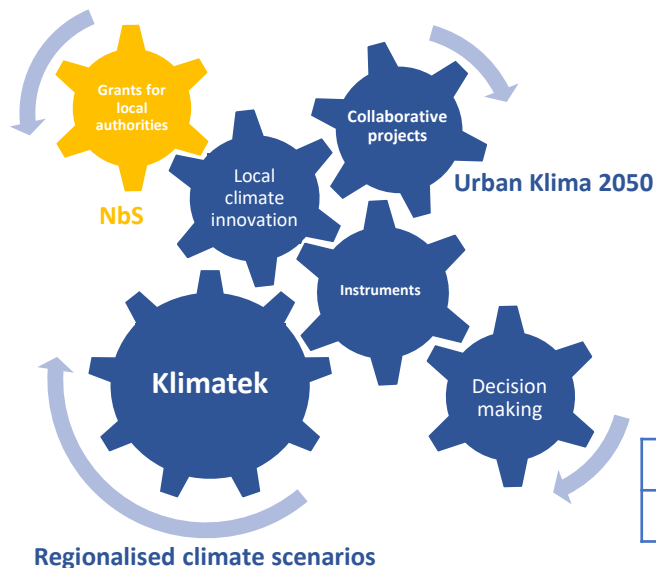

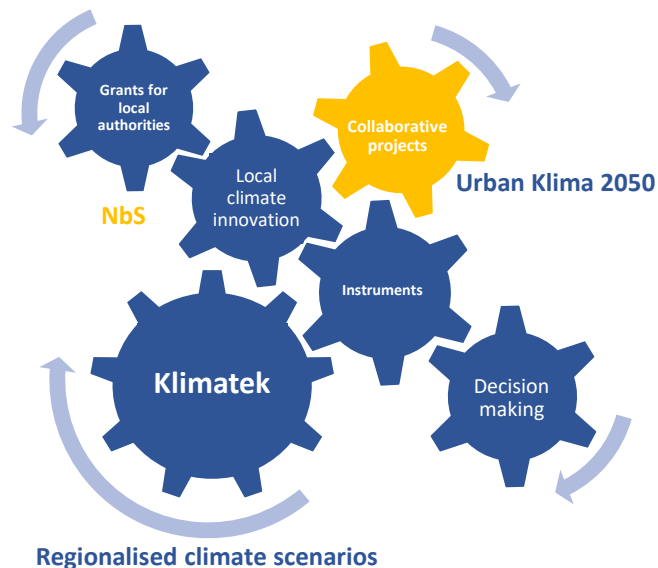


Collaboration with local administrations through Udalsarea 2030 for networking and promoting sustainable local action
