Project labelling

- From 2017-2020, AG4 developed a methodology allowing for the assessment of projects in the transport and mobility sector according to pre-defined criteria
- The developed methodology serves to identify projects with a relevance for the fostering of sustainable mobility solutions in the Alpine Region from a macroregional perspective.
- Two rounds of assessments were finalised in 2020 and 2021, generating a set of 20 projects receiving the EUSALP AG4 Label
- The awarded EUSALP AG4 Label shall support the projects in their implementation and to attract adequate financial support
